The first guest speaker of the day was Mr. Garland Land, Director of State Center for Health Statistics, Missouri Division of Health, Jefferson City, Missouri. Mr. Land presented to the group an informative talk entitled "Vital Statistics as a 'Vital' Tool in Follow-up".

At 12:00 p.m. the meeting was recessed for lunch.

Attention was then directed to Dr. Andrew McCanse, Liason American College of Surgeons, K.C. Metro; Director Tumor Registry K.C. General Hospital and Medical Center, Kansas City, Missouri. Dr. McCanse spoke to the association on "Hospital Based Tumor Registry as Integral Part of Patient Care.


